Reports:

President – Todd Johnson

- Uniforms – all items should be in at SoccerWest (SW).

VP Operations – Jeff Hemmen

- Volunteer hours – GRFC only has been given 2 weekends for parking volunteer hours. Weekend of July 20th needs 20 people for shifts.
- Other volunteer hours opportunities include auction/golf tournament and GRFC Winter Classic. All funds received for volunteer hours go to help support the scholarship fund.

Registrar – Rich Turner

- Soliciting full refund from Rainier Challenge. Teams to contact to let Kaelen know if they are going to substitute a tournament or want funds sent to team account.
- Rainier Challenge – all girl teams paid and only some of the boy teams
- Crossfire Challenge – Sending check for all teams registered. E-mail sent out to all Team Managers to go into Crossfire “Got Soccer” account and complete roster and team information.
- Lake Oswego – Club to pay registration fee for all teams registered.
- All other tournaments the team will pay from their accounts and request reimbursement. Need to follow reimbursement policy.

- Roster/Player Cards – for Washington State tournaments request roster one week in advance from Rich. Oregon tournaments have mutual interstate agreement and process same as for Washington. However, Lake Oswego tournament is requesting travel papers. Team Managers need to read tournament rules to determine what they need for roster and travel papers.
- When player roster is ‘final’ contact Rich to print player cards and he will get printed.
- US Club cards – Cost \$16.00. Request after July 1st, cards will be good for 13 months. E-mail to go out to all older teams on how to get US Club cards.
