- Fall season going good – few complaints
- Lost & Found link on the website. Please contact webmaster if you find GRFC gear so he can list it on the website. As a club we need to take ownership of picking up and reporting lost gear so we can help each other out.
- Uniform Re-Order – club uniform re-order should be in later this at SoccerWest. Carleena will be handling and getting items needing printing to Kickit. Carleena will be contacting Uniform Coordinators when ready to pick-up.
- GRFC Winter Classic –
 - GRFC teams need to get registered now. All GRFC teams need to register and select payment type = checking, but don't send payment to club as club already has your funds for this tournament.
 - Please make sure to register your team name as follows “Club Name-Year-Color” (ex. GRFC 95 Blue). Do not add coaches name at end or girls or boys in front of year.
 - Team Manager to keep networking with other clubs and let them know about our tournament and invite them to come play.
 - Currently have 60- 70 teams registered. Teams registered include Crossfire, Seattle United, Eastside, Washington Premier, Snohomish, teams from Oregon, and others.
 - Possibly will be Thursday night games for local teams.
 - Tournament helps earn funds for scholarships.

VP Operations – Jeff Hemmen

- Required Volunteer Hour update –
 - Team Managers and Treasurers should have received several emails to get their spreadsheet verifying Volunteer Hours in to Jeff.
 - Club is zeroing in on those families that have not volunteered or paid the buyout.
 - Most teams have three or four families that need to complete their required club volunteer hours.
 - Seven teams still need to turn in the spreadsheet with the information regarding which families have completed their requirement or still need to volunteer or pay the buyout.
- New process for Required Club Volunteer Hours
 - Club will be applying Green/Yellow/Red status to the Required Club Volunteer program. Families that have not signed up or contacted Jeff to volunteer will get a Yellow (warning) on January 1, 2011 and families that receive yellow status do not contact Jeff by January 18, 2011 they will go into Red status.
 - Green/Yellow/Red will work the same way as club payments. Players with red status will have player cards pulled and will not be able to participate in practice, games, or team events until status is returned to green. Green/Yellow/Red for volunteer hours will not be using the accounting system to generate yellow/red status. Any families in Red status for volunteer hours will be getting a letter from the board not the Team Managers.
 - On December 10, 2010 a volunteer list will be published with a list of jobs needing volunteers who need to fulfill their time. Families will have 10 days to sign up. The list will be posted on the website under Volunteer link and will be going out to the families that still need to complete their required volunteer hours for the club. There may be some volunteer position available prior to the GRFC Winter Classic.
 - Volunteers need to help keep process going forward by signing up. Families needing to complete their required hours need to contact Jeff. Jeff will assign job and date. If you don't have a date you don't have a job.
- Uniform Coordinators will be getting credited the full ten hours for this year.

VP Development – Kyle Janders (Fields)

- Boys U15 & older state cup times changed. Dates have been moved to begin earlier.
- Boys teams will begin practicing last week of December to prepare for the changed dates.
- Devs – looking for fields. Have some options by Newcastle. Teams would have to setup the field with wuzzies and goals.
