Re: Soccer Procedures at Renton Memorial Stadium

1. **There is no food allowed on the turf or track. This includes gum, sunflower seeds and candy. We have brand new turf and want to keep it nice!**
2. The only acceptable drink on the stadium turf is **WATER**. No Gatorade, PowerAides, etc. as the sugar base of all these drinks will corrode the wash water drainage system located under the turf. Athletes are also asked not to use any kind of greasy rubs (i.e. Ben Gay) as this stains the turf.
3. Coaches need to supervise their athletes. Coaches are responsible for the security of the locker rooms (if rented for your event) and field equipment; any damage sustained to the locker rooms or equipment during a soccer game will be billed to your organization.
4. The only people allowed along the sidelines during a soccer game are eligible players, in uniform; trainers, statisticians and coaches. Any player that is not eligible to play must sit in the **south** stands. Do not bring them on the field when your team enters the stadium.
5. The north stands are closed to spectators. No one is allowed in the north stands during a soccer match unless prior arrangement has been made for team use only. Please inform your coaches and non eligible players of this.
6. Only team benches provided by Renton Stadium are allowed on the track. No "Easy-up" tents/canopies are allowed on the track surface.
7. Teams are expected to clean up the area before they leave. Any extra custodial time required to clean team bench areas or north stands will be charged to your organization.
